DENVER BRONCOS 2008 TRAINING CAMP SCHEDULE AND MEDIA INFORMATION

Opening Barbeque with Press and Coaching Staff: The 2008 Denver Broncos training camp will kick off on **Thursday, July 24**, with the team's annual press barbeque. This will be held at the Paul D. Bowlen Memorial Broncos Centre in the dining area of the facility and on the adjacent patio area. Head Coach Mike Shanahan as well as assistant coaches will address the media and answer questions at some point during the barbeque, which will be held from 12-1 p.m. A select number of Broncos players also will be available to the press on the patio area during the afternoon.

Daily Schedule: The Broncos' first practice of their 2008 training camp will be held at their training facility on the morning of **Friday, July 25**, and their final camp practice that is open to the public for viewing will occur in the afternoon on **Tuesday, Aug. 12**. Denver also will practice with the Dallas Cowboys on Aug. 13 and 14 at its facility, but those sessions will be open to the media only.

The complete training camp schedule is listed at the bottom of this advisory. **Please note that practice times and dates are subject to change without notice.** Morning practices are scheduled to begin at 8:30 a.m. with gates open starting at 7:30 a.m. Afternoon practices featuring the full team are set to begin at 3:50 p.m. while special teams only practices in the afternoon will start at 3:40 p.m. Gates for the afternoon sessions also will be open starting one hour before the practice begins.

Media Parking: Members of the media will park in Lot A, which is located to the west of the Broncos' training facility. The media parking area will be supervised by security. A limited number of parking passes will be available for media organizations to pick up at the press barbeque on Thursday, July 24.

Media Access to Practice: Media access will be granted by camp credentials, which will be issued by the Broncos' media relations department. The credentials are valid for the duration of training camp and will include a photo ID. Media members may obtain credentials for training camp in the Broncos' press room, where a member of the media relations department will be present to assist them. Please note that these credentials will not be valid for games at INVESCO Field at Mile High. On their first visit, media members are encouraged to allow a few extra minutes to get their camp press credential, which will be processed on site upon their arrival. Access is strictly limited to working media only, and the media may not bring guests to practice. In line with regular Broncos policy, any cell phone activity of any type is prohibited at practice. No tripods can be used except on the sidewalk and patio areas, and the press cannot be "between fields" if there is any activity on both of those fields.

Live Shot Locations: The primary designated area for live shots is located in front of the helmet on the outside wall in front of the Broncos' training facility. The area immediately inside the press gate, off the field and immediately adjacent to the wall will be available for live shots only if the team is completely finished and no one is on the playing field.

Editing Trailers for Local TV Stations: Television stations interested in parking an editing trailer at training camp should contact John Karpan of the Broncos' operations department at (303) 649-0581.

Mike Shanahan Availability: Head Coach Mike Shanahan will be available to the press in a group setting after each practice, excluding special teams practices, as in past years. Requests for individual interviews with Coach Shanahan must be made through the club's media relations department.

Player Access: As in previous camps, players will be available for interviews coming off the practice field, and the locker room will be closed to the media. During the lunch period, players will be available on the patio area adjacent to the dining hall. There will be no evening access to players or coaches.

Admission: Practices at the team's headquarters are open to the public and admission is free. Please refer to the schedule at the bottom of this advisory for specific dates and times of the practices.

Fan Parking: Parking at the Broncos' facility is located on the west side of the practice fields and is open on a first-come, first-served basis. Because space is limited, please arrive early. The parking area is open one hour before the start of practice.

ADA: Admission to the Denver Broncos' 2008 training camp will be ADA accessible.

General Seating: There will be no bleachers at the Broncos' 2008 training camp, but fans will be able to stand and view the practices from selected areas that will be marked clearly on site.

Lawn Chairs: Lawn chairs will not be allowed at training camp.

Bag Policy: Soft-sided bags no larger than 12" x 12" x 12" will be permitted at training camp.

Cell Phones: Any cellular phones brought to the practice fields at the training facility must be turned off or silent, and no cellular phone activity of any kind is permitted inside ticketed areas. Fans must be outside the fenced-in areas in order to place any cell phone calls.

Cameras: Still cameras will be allowed at the Broncos' 2008 training camp, but video cameras will not be permitted. Only members of the media will be allowed to bring cameras with professional lenses and tripods to training camp.

Autographs: A select number of Broncos players and one coach will be available for autographs after full squad practices. Each fan will be limited to one autograph per player and coach.

Food and Beverages: Food concessions will not be sold during training camp, but non-alcoholic beverages will be available for purchase at training camp. Food and non-alcoholic beverage items will be permitted in small individual quantities.

Umbrellas: Umbrellas of any size will not be permitted inside the Broncos' training facility. Please bring sufficient wet weather attire if necessary.

Team Store: The Broncos' team store will be temporarily relocated adjacent to the practice fields during training camp. This area will be clearly marked.
