Dear Mr. Glickler:

Pursuant to our conversation, enclosed please find the materials we discussed concerning targets Robert Wayne Mitchell and Markeya Mitchell. This matter involves a conflict of interest for the Dallas County District Attorney's Office and we are requesting the assistance of your office to prosecute the case.

This investigation was referred to our office by Dallas Police Officer Charlie Shields who works in the Financial Crimes Investigations Unit. The case involves a home at 2909 Bonnie View Road, Dallas, Texas which had been owned by Ella Mae Walker since 1954. Ms. Walker died on November 17, 2004. Ms. Walker's only heir, Kenneth Moore, inherited the property. On or about January 2, 2007, the defendant Robert Wayne Mitchell, filed a warranty deed transferring the property to himself. The deed had purportedly been signed by the grantor, Ella Mae Walker, on June 10, 2005, approximately seven months after she had died. Markeya Mitchell notarized the document. Markeya Mitchell's handwriting looks very similar to the purported signature of Ella Mae Walker on the deed.

On July 17, 2007, Robert Mitchell sold 2909 Bonnie View Road to the Good Street Baptist Church. The sale transaction was closed at the Fidelity National Title office owned by Dallas County District Attorney Craig Watkins. Mr. Watkins apparently rendered some legal services for the title company and his wife notarized some of the documents. Because Mr. Watkins and his wife are

potential witnesses in this case, the Dallas County District Attorney's Office is seeking the assistance of your office on this matter.

There are two additional cases involving Mr. Mitchell that are similar to the matter being referred to your office. However, they were closed at another title company and do not involve the conflict present in the Ella Mae Walker matter.

Please review the enclosed materials at your convenience and give me a call. Our office will help you in any way we can and appreciate your assistance. Mitchell has three prior trips to the penitentiary from the 1980's. He presently has three cases pending in Criminal District Court 4, Dallas County which are tentatively set for trial on April 7.
