Russell Dale Martin, W/M, DOB 10/04/1960



ARREST WARRANT AFFIDAVIT

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared the undersigned affiant, who after being duly sworn on oath, deposes and says: My name is **Richard Anderson**, a Detective for the City of Southlake Department of Public Safety and I have good reason to believe and do believe that on or about **July 14, 2008**, in TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, **Russell Dale Martin, W/M, DOB 10/04/1960**, did then and there commit the offense of:

Aggravated Assault-Bodily Injury-Deadly Weapon, 22.02 (A)(2)(PC)

In that he did then and there intentionally cause bodily injury to [REDACTED] by pulling hair out of her head, pushing her against a wall, and kicking her in the leg and the defendant did exhibit a deadly weapon during the commission of the assault, to-wit: a Glock Semiautomatic Pistol.

My belief is based on the following facts and information: on July 14, 2008 Officer Ric Salas was dispatched to take a report of family violence from a victim at the Southlake DPS West Facility. The victim was identified as [REDACTED]. As a result of this report, case number 08SP033122 was generated and is maintained as a permanent record at the Southlake Department of Public Safety.

After Officer Salas took the original report, your affiant took over the investigation. Your affiant asked [REDACTED] about her injuries and she told your affiant that her head had been injured because her fiancé, Russell Martin, had grabbed her by her hair and threw her around. She said she had several red spots on the back of her head where her hair had been ripped out of her head. She also had an abrasion behind her right ear. [REDACTED] also said that Russell Martin kicked her and she had a bruise on her left thigh. Your affiant did observe these injuries and they were consistent with the victim's statement.

Your affiant then asked [REDACTED] to describe the relationship she had with Russell Martin. [REDACTED] said she was engaged to be married to a man she identified as Russell D. Martin. She told your affiant that they have been dating for over three years

and that they are currently living together at his residence located at 1430 Byron Nelson Parkway in Southlake, Tarrant County, Texas. [REDACTED] stated that they have had an intimate partner relationship during this time. [REDACTED] stated that the assault took place at this residence. Your affiant then asked her to go over in detail the events that took place prior to and during the incident. [REDACTED] said that Russell Martin has been involved in some type of audit/investigation with the IRS and this has stressed him out. Mr. Martin had sent a package to the IRS agent with documents that had been requested. On Monday July 14, 2008 at approximately 21:15 hours, [REDACTED] received a phone call from Russell Martin. Mr. Martin wanted to know if she followed up with a phone call to the IRS agent to verify the package was received. [REDACTED] said that she did not make a phone call to the agent and he became irate over the telephone. [REDACTED] said he was yelling at her telling her that she did not understand how serious it was and the IRS was trying to take his house and everything he owned. Mr. Martin's verbal tirade continued and he hung up. [REDACTED] said Russell Martin called back and continued yelling at her and he ended by making the following threat: "You better hide because when I get there I'm going to beat the shit out of you!"

[REDACTED] said that there have been previous incidents similar to this and that she knew it was going to be bad when he got home. [REDACTED] said that she went to her office upstairs and turned on her recorder so she could tape the incident. Mr. Martin then arrived at approximately 21:30 hours. He came in the house and began screaming for [REDACTED] to come down. [REDACTED] did not want to go downstairs because she had the recorder running in her office. Mr. Martin then came upstairs and entered [REDACTED] personal office. Mr. Martin continued his screaming tirade and began kicking and pushing her desk. [REDACTED] said he destroyed the desk and part of it was a bookcase that contained other personal items such as pictures personal items that were knocked off onto the floor. The desk banged into the wall and a picture on the wall fell and was broken.

Mr. Martin then grabbed [REDACTED] personal laptop and began banging it on the desk trying to break it. [REDACTED] said it was her company computer that she kept all the company records on. She tried to get it from him and that is when he grabbed her by the hair and began pushing her around. She said he grabbed her hair five or six times and was pulling chunks of hair out of her head. [REDACTED] said she finally got out of the room and went downstairs. Mr. Martin followed her down and the fight continued. Martin then kicked her full force on her left thigh.

[REDACTED] then tried to get her laptop and her possessions, but Russell Martin blocked her from doing so and kept pushing her into a wall. [REDACTED] then told him she wanted the laptop because it contains her personal and business records. [REDACTED] said she went into the kitchen begging him for the laptop and Russell was leaning against the counter. Russell Martin stood up and pulled his Glock pistol from behind his back and held it in front of him and pulled the slide back loading a round and cocking the hammer. He then started pacing around the kitchen holding the gun. He then stopped and dropped the magazine out and removed several bullets into his hand. [REDACTED] said that he was using the gun to intimidate her to keep her from getting her things. [REDACTED] said she then decided to leave and she went out and got into her car. As she was leaving, Martin came down the driveway and gave her the laptop. [REDACTED] gave him the key and she left the house with only her computer and she went to stay with her parents in Plano, Texas. [REDACTED] said that he had destroyed the laptop and it was completely unusable.

In summary, on July 14, 2008 Russell D. Martin did then and there intentionally cause bodily injury to [REDACTED], by pulling hair out of her head, pushing her against a wall, and kicking her in the leg. The incident caused injury and pain to [REDACTED]. During the assaultive incident Russell Martin did exhibit a deadly weapon to-wit: a Glock Semiautomatic Pistol. The incident occurred in Southlake, Tarrant County, Texas.

A check of computerized driver's license records shows **Russell Dale Martin** holds Texas driver's license number **00117700**.

A computerized criminal history check was run the following criminal history was located:

Wherefore, I request that an arrest warrant be issued for the suspect hereinafter designated according to the laws of this State.
