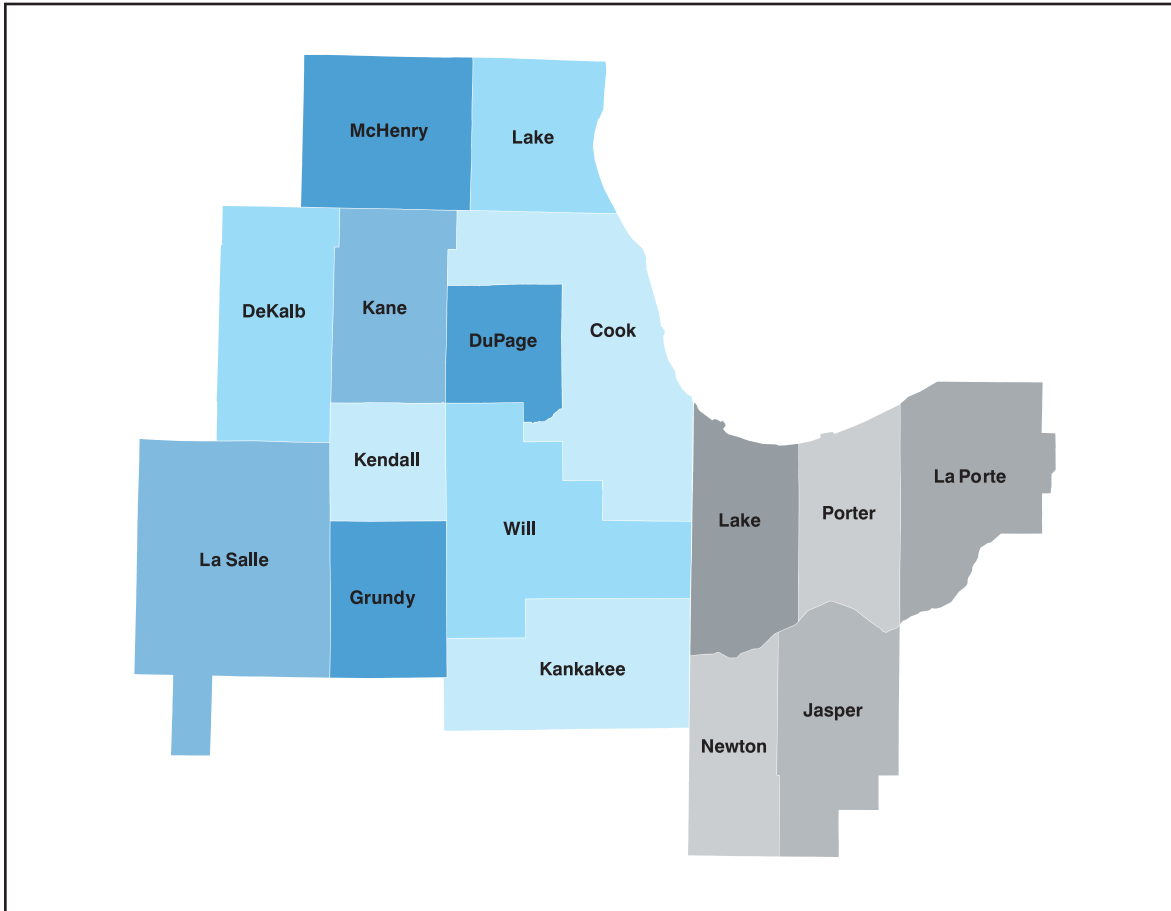




SEVERE WEATHER

Use this map to pinpoint the location of an active watch or warning.



A **“Watch”** means that conditions are right for that event to happen. For example, if we say there’s a “Severe Thunderstorm Watch” for an area, that means severe weather is possible, but not imminent. It’s an early heads-up that some severe weather may occur in the designated area.

A **“Warning”** means the condition will happen or is already happening. Thus, a “Severe Thunderstorm Warning” means that severe thunderstorms are happening now in the warning area and you should seek shelter or take precautions immediately.
