

# Supporting Affidavit For Request To Issue Arrest Warrant

**INSTRUCTION:** A person seeking an arrest warrant shall appear personally before any justice or justices of the peace, and shall give an affidavit in the form hereinafter prescribed. The affidavit shall contain facts, information and circumstances upon which such person relies to establish probable cause for the issuance of the warrant, and the affidavit may be supplemented by oral statements, under oath for the establishment of probable cause. The person issuing the warrant shall retain the affidavit and shall make notes personally of any oral statements under oath supplementing the affidavit or arrange for transcript to be made of such oral statements.

**PROBABLE CAUSE IS DEFINED AS:** "An apparent state of facts found to exist upon reasonable inquiry, which would induce a reasonably intelligent and prudent (person) to believe, in a criminal case, that the accused person had committed the crime charged."

I, DETECTIVE KRISTEN L GORE, being duly sworn, herewith make application for the issuance of an Arrest warrant against the defendant:

Defendant's Name: Melinda Dennehy

DOB: 02/20/1969

I have information that the crime of Indecent Exposure and Lewdness has been committed by the defendant as follows:

1. I am a Detective with the Londonderry Police Department where I have been employed since 2001. I am currently assigned to the criminal investigations unit and have been since 2008. Prior to my current assignment, I have worked in the Uniformed Patrol operations Division as a Patrol Officer, a Field Training Officer, and a Technical Accident Reconstruction Team Member. I received my police certification through the New Hampshire Police Standards and Training Council in Concord, New Hampshire in June 2001. Prior to my current employment, I was employed at the Brooksville Police Department in Brooksville, Florida for over eight years time as a certified police officer. In my seventeen plus years as a police officer, I have received hundreds of hours of training in police related topics to include, Interviews and Interrogations, Domestic and Sexual Violence, Investigative Technique Training, Use of Force, Weapons and Tactical Training, Sexual Harassment, At Scene Traffic Accident Investigation, and Technical Accident Investigation. I am currently investigating a case of indecent exposure in violation of RSA 645:1.
2. I have information, based upon interviews with several male juvenile witnesses that Melinda Dennehy an English teacher employed at the Londonderry High School, in Londonderry New Hampshire, sent at least (1)one picture of herself with her genitals exposed to A [REDACTED] R [REDACTED] whose date of birth is October 2, 1994. A copy of this picture is in the possession of the Londonderry Police Department. This picture has been identified by co-workers to be that of Melinda Dennehy.
3. On March 3, 2010 at approximately 11:39 a.m. it was reported to School Resource Officer Adam Lane by Assistant Principal Greg Warren at the Londonderry High School that inappropriate picture(s) of a female teacher were being distributed through out the high school by students. School Resource Officer Adam Lane then met with Assistant Principal Katie Sullivan and juvenile A [REDACTED] R [REDACTED]. A [REDACTED] R [REDACTED] then disclosed that approximately two months ago, his teacher Melinda Dennehy had sent him (4)four nude pictures of herself to his hotmail email account. A [REDACTED] R [REDACTED] then emailed the pictures he received to two of his friends S [REDACTED] O [REDACTED] and J [REDACTED] F [REDACTED]. A [REDACTED] R [REDACTED]'s father B [REDACTED] A [REDACTED] provided an email that showed the nude picture of Melinda Dennehy being sent from jdenneh@aol.com to [REDACTED]@hotmail.com.
4. Juvenile A [REDACTED] R [REDACTED] also disclosed that Melinda Dennehy had continuously sent him text messages. In some of those messages Dennehy told R [REDACTED] that she wanted to give him a "blow job".
5. A [REDACTED] R [REDACTED] reported that in the past two months time, Melinda Dennehy kissed him twice on two separate
